#### **Christmas Lights**

The Town Council was pleased to once again contribute to the annual Christmas Fayre and Christmas Lights Switch-on in Bingley town centre. Amongst the lights on the trees and lamp-posts this year was a new light designed by 8-year-old Chloe Haran from Eldwick Primary School. Chloe won the Town Council's 2019 competition for pupils at local schools to come up with an idea for a new Christmas light, and was presented with her prize by Stuart McCall. Congratulations Chloe!

At its full council meeting on 26th November, the Town Council approved additional expenditure on some new Christmas rope lights in Crossflatts. The Town Council's light provider/installer has advised that they will be lit in time for the Crossflatts Christmas lights switch-on taking place on 8 December at 5 pm.





A passing remark regarding articles on this back page was that many of the locations mentioned in the text were unknown. Obviously in the context of the historic periods often used in such writing it seemed fitting to use this illustration. It is a copy of what was probably Eldwick's first simple hand-drawn map by Jonathan Taylor in 1817. To orientate oneself look at No 7 termed Brick Kiln – today's Park Top Cottages, No 17, the then heart of the village with the Eldwick Mill Dam at the junction of Otley Road with The Green to the Acorn, Otley Road up to Dick Hudsons - No 26 High Gate Farm, and Spring Lane to No 40 Glovershaw, then without an extension to the High Road to Otley. Today it is possible to walk from near Eldwick Hall (22/23) across the fields to Birch Close at No 31 instead of turning up Tunstall Lane up to No 41 Whitecroft, to Faweather and

beyond. Virtually all the properties on the map, which of course in 1817 were not numbered as here, were small farms producing cereals as well as root crops with sheep, cattle and pigs for both domestic and commercial use. Note No 16 the Corn Mill which was obviously an important facility. To the west and southwest, the present Parkside bend is obvious with the quarry above ( Prince of Wales Park by 1865), and the north-south line from No1 to No 12 was the Gilstead to Morton Road, now Warren Lane to Heights Lane. No 8 would be used for the Gilstead Filter Beds and the Allotments. No 38 was the farm opposite, down today's Slate Quarry Lane, with the 1862 Warren Park House as a later addition. No 12 Lane End Farm has records dating back to the times of Queen Elizabeth I whereas Eldwick Hall

and many other of the farms existed from the 17th and 18th centuries. Even in my time of first researching Eldwick history some 40 years ago, many of the locations on the map were still farms. Happily, their change of use to domestic properties has by and large been undertaken with due consideration to their history.
