Our 72nd Annual Show is to be held in the Memorial Hall and Church Sunday School on Saturday 26th August. After judging is completed the public will be admitted at 3.00 p.m. the official opening by Mr. S. Harrison of Eldwick will be at 3.15 p.m. There is no admission charge but a Silver Collection will be taken at the door.
